

NOTICE TO CONSUMERS
of the CLARKE COUNTY SANITARY AUTHORITY WATERWORKS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

State Health Officials have advised us of a failure to perform required monitoring in accordance with the *Virginia Waterworks Regulations*.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the May 2018 monitoring period, we did not monitor for the chlorine residual concentration at the same time and location as the sample collected. Therefore, we cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

State Health Officials believe that there is little need for concern about the safety of your water because past records show that our waterworks has had no documented problems with bacteriological contamination; however, routine sampling and examination are required to determine the quality of water delivered to our customers.

There is nothing you need to do at this time. This situation has been resolved.
