## RECREATION CENTER RULES

The trail is shared and enjoyed by bicyclists, pedestrians, runners, dog walkers, baby strollers and persons in wheel chairs. Please follow the trail rules and use courtesy and common sense to avoid collisions, especially when the trail is crowded.

1. All persons using the Recreation Center facilities must pay in accordance with the approved fee schedule.
2. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. A paying adult must directly supervise persons under the age of fifteen using the weight room.
4. All youth groups must have one adult chaperone for every eight children.
5. Food and drinks are not allowed in hallways or the gymnasium.
6. Gum, alcohol, drugs, and tobacco products are prohibited.
7. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times outside the locker room facilities.
8. Pets are prohibited inside the Recreation Center, with the exception of service dogs.
9. Indoor athletic shoes are to be worn when using the gymnasium. No sandals, street shoes, or dark-soled shoes.
10. Slam dunking and hanging on basketball rims is prohibited.
11. Foul, abusive language and behavior is prohibited.
12. Running and bouncing of balls will be confined to the gymnasium.
13. Headphones/earbuds are required with music players, phones, and any other listening devices in the Recreation Center.
14. When using the fitness room, a maximum of 15 minutes per station is permitted when people are waiting.

Violation of any of these rules could result in the patron being asked to leave the Recreation Center for the rest of the day. Severe or repeat violations may result in the patron being banned from the Recreation Center a set period of time or permanently.
